McColl.This will be followed by a discussion on the revised road policy. Both items are extremely relevent to the future of the park so please make every effort to come and urge your neighbours and friends to join you.

As the responsibility for operating and managing the park passes to Saanich under a revised Crown Grant it is very important that as many people as possible understand how this system works: Mr. McColl has been intimately involved in the arrangements for the transfer of the park from Victoria to Saanich and will be the Crown's agent when Saanich assumes its full responsibilities. His views of what can and cannot be done to change the park to meet the future needs of the community will give us an excellent point of reference as the pressures for change mount.

At the last meeting we tabled a statement on road policy for the park. The executive will present a revised version for discussion modification and adoption.

Now that we have a constitution and by-laws we are able to apply for status of a society. The details will be presented at the meeting together with updates on the transmitter site, the proposals for the master plan being prepared for Saanich by a team of consultants and the November referendum.

It is a pleasure to record the outcome of our discussions with Saanich Parks Department concerning the sewer line for the wash rooms. The new route will follow the road and not go through the trees as originally planned. The change represents the first tangible outcome of this group's efforts to work in collaboration with the park managers; come to the next meeting and make sure there will be more to follow.
