



Fun Fact About LIVING STUMPS

When a tree falls, its stump may remain alive for hundreds of years! These are called living stumps and they have the ability to heal, and continue living off of shared nutrients from neighbouring trees. This is possible through a complex network of fungi, which scientists refer to as the wood wide web, allowing trees to share resources and communicate!
